

# Fiji Mahogany

Fiji mahogany is a genuine big leaf mahogany (*Swietenia Macrophylla*) planted with appropriate seedlings 40-60 years ago.

Over the years, these forests have developed into the world's finest mahogany plantations due to the ideal climate and soil content for excellent growth. All harvesting is managed in a fully sustainable manner with a positive annual growth.



The sapwood is distinct but not clearly demarcated from the heartwood. The heartwood is reddish or pinkish brown when freshly cut, turning into a deep rich red brown color after exposure.

The grain is straight to slightly interlocked. Depending on the cut, it often produces a highly attractive figure. The texture is fine or medium, and uniform. The surface of the wood is naturally high in luster.
